❖ **Aim:** To introduce students to the real pharmaceutical scenario and to expose them to experiential learning.

❖ **Objectives:**

2. To observe the various equipment used in pharmaceutical industry
3. To observe the process of manufacturing of dosage forms
4. To observe the various departments of industry
5. To observe the packing process of different dosages forms

❖ **Introduction:**

Academic visits to pharmaceutical industry sites are organised as part of study units related to pharmaceutical production processes. These visits are held to introduce students to the real pharmaceutical scenario and to expose them to experiential learning. During visits students are shown how the daily activities are performed at the different pharmaceutical settings. Students have the opportunity to see and learn more about the equipment used for pharmaceutical processes and analysis. They are also exposed to the documentation system used and the importance of documentation in these settings. The industrial visits help pharmaceutical technology students to better understand concepts and processes covered during the course. The students have the opportunity to familiarize with activities performed in this setting.

An industrial tour for the First year of D. Pharm was organized at S.G. Phyto Pharma Pvt. Ltd. And PATCO Healthcare Pvt. Ltd. Kolhapur. The visit was a one day tour from campus to Kolhapur and back. The visit was organized on Friday, 23rd November 2018.

We left for Kolhapur at around 05.30 am and reached at around 11.30 am, where we gave first visit to S. G. Phyto Pharma Pvt. Ltd. Kolhapur. We had received and welcomed by Mr. Sagar Tare, Production Manager, S. G. Phyto Pharma Pvt. Ltd. He has shared a nice interaction about the experiences regarding profession and introduced all the departments of their industry along with respective departmental head. Mr. Ganesh Bhosale, senior lab chemist and Suresh Jagdale, Production Supervisor Who guided and explained about processing of pharmaceutical products at various stages of visit to pharma plant. The student were very happy and felt enriched after visiting a pharma manufacturing plant. Overall visit of industry had completed in 01:15 hrs. Then we go for where the lunch was organized at Jain Hotel, Near MIDC, Kolhapur.

sections of pharma industry like QC, QA, Dispensing, Manufacturing (Compression, granulation etc.) and Packaging etc.

The students had watch to manufacturing of oral liquid dosage forms. All the products were manufactured as per regulatory guidelines of DCGI, USFDA, MHRA and WHO. Students were allowed to closely observe the online production of various products, bulk packaging of products. The various large-scale pharma manufacturing equipment and its applications were also keenly observed by our students. This made our students to correlate their theory with practical application in pharma manufacturing field.

The plant is manufacturing oral solids – particularly tablets, Capsules, and Dry Powders and also Oral liquids. After the interaction students were divided in each 10 for the round in the unit. In this round students were taken through storage facilities, manufacturing facilities, packaging facilities etc. and The visit was so exciting and interactive that it took us around two and a half hours to just have a look on available facilities. At the end after coming out of the company, students individually thanked the officials for permitting them to visit such an exceptional pharmaceutical unit. They also appreciated the college for organizing such an event, which will help them decide their path towards success in future.

With an expectation of more such industrial visits, we started our journey back to the campus at around 4.15 pm. The tour reached campus at 08.00 pm. The tour was comfortable and entertaining.
