It is the second major killer infectious disease after tuberculosis, and 9 times more people are infected with hepatitis than HIV. Hepatitis is preventable, treatable, and in the case of hepatitis C, curable. However, over 80% of people living with hepatitis are lacking prevention, testing and treatment services. In particular, the Assembly requested the World Health Organization (WHO) to develop, in collaboration with Member States, necessary measures, guidelines, strategies, time-bound goals and tools for the surveillance, prevention and control of viral hepatitis. By keeping in mind this serious issue of society the Yashwantrao Bhonsale College of D.
